Ms. Pettit reported that Tim Harris who is CDOT's Chief Engineer has an initiative to *fund* assignments by end March from the Faster fund collection of registration fees on car license renewals that come in quarterly. Highway 50 around the dealerships is an example project that cannot meet the March deadline because of *Right A Way* issues, and was swapped in the same corridor so that those funds cannot be redirected elsewhere. All seven TPR Enhancement projects were funded by a surplus in the *2011 Federal Reconciliation*. The DOT's road to the Pueblo Chemical Depot has a CDOT commitment and that funding of \$500,000 is held in reserve for the next phase until Federal Funds are billed first.

Ms. Pettit reported that the applicants are funding the design on their projects. All CDOT funds will be used specifically on construction only.

(5) MPO Staff Report – Scott Hobson and Pepper Whittlef

The Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) on the US 50 West Study is in the process order (PEL Report, LRTP, MOA) that goes first to Pueblo City Council, Pueblo County and Pueblo West.

The city of Pueblo is in discussion with Pueblo County Planning and the PACOG Board to update the *integrating elements* in the Pueblo Regional Comprehension Plan.

The LRTP updates and adjustments requested by *FHWA* will be presented in February or March to

TAC Committee and PACOG Board for approval. These updates and adjustments are of *the preferred budget scenario* of *High, Medium and Low budget scenarios* that will be based on anticipated real dollars.

There were no TIGER III Grants awarded to Colorado. The Dillon Flyover Project was an applicant that has two stages. The Phase 1 of the project is scheduled to start in spring of 2012.

The PACOG website is being maintained by Pueblo IT department as we update TIP Amendments and other PACOG Planning information.

Mr. Hobson reported that PACOG along with three other Front Range MPOs agreed several years ago to participate financially in the Front Range Counts Study project. The PACOG contribution was set at \$110,000 spreading payment across the five years (2009-2013) in yearly increments of \$22,000. This activity is included in the UPWP under 2.6 to update the Long Range Transportation Plan. Ms. Merrifield reported that the travel models are used to help plan for future transportation needs in each area along the Front Range. This study information will provide vital base information such as travel patterns along the Front Range that will help evaluated and prioritized different regional transportation projects and eligibility for federal transportation funding.

Alf Randal asked Wendy Pettit about the application results of the Winter County Conference on 2012 Bridge Off- System funding awards. Wendy said the CDOT Bridge Committee has already met because the 11th Street funds have been awarded. She has not received any other details about other projects. She will be in Denver within the next couple weeks and will inquire about the awards for Region II.

John Batey brought to attention the matching funds for some of the Enhancement Projects showed State contribution. Mr. Hobson went back and corrected them based on the applications.
