

RESOLUTION NO. 2024.024

A RESOLUTION ASSIGNING FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION CHARGING AND FUELING INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,120,679.20 AND ASSIGNING COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY MATCHING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$780,169.80 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A HYDROGEN FUELING STATION AT COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY PUEBLO.

WHEREAS, Federal Highway Administration Charging and Fueling Infrastructure Grant Funds awarded \$3,120,679.20 to Colorado State University Pueblo; and

WHEREAS, Colorado State University approved funds of \$780,169.80 to be used as match for the Construction of a Hydrogen Fueling Station at Colorado State University Pueblo.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PUEBLO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS that:

SECTION 1:

The Pueblo Area Council of Governments expresses its desire to use Charging and Fueling Infrastructure Grant funds and Colorado State University match funds for a total of \$3,900,849.00 to construct a hydrogen fueling station at Colorado State University Pueblo.

SECTION 2:

The PACOG certifies that the transportation planning process is being carried out in conformance with all applicable federal requirements; and hereby directs the Urban Transportation Planning Division to implement the necessary revisions to the Fiscal Year 2025–2028 Pueblo Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Improvement Program to include this amendment.

SECTION 3:


This Resolution shall become effective upon passage and approval.
