

RESOLUTION NO. 25-033

A RESOLUTION ASSIGNING COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FEDERAL HAZARD ELIMINATION PROGRAM (HAZ) FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$436,500, FEDERAL HOTSPOT PROGRAM (HOT) FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$82,790 AND STATE MATCHING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$65,710 FOR A TOTAL OF \$585,000 FOR THE INSTALLATION OF REFLECTIVE BACKPLATES TO VARIOUS TRAFFIC SIGNAL HEADS.

WHEREAS, Colorado Department of Transportation assigned federal Hazard Elimination Program (HAZ) Funds in the amount of \$436,500; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Department of Transportation assigned federal Hotspot Program (HOT) Funds in the amount of \$82,790; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Department of Transportation assigned state match funds in the amount of \$65,710 for the installation of yellow reflective backplates to traffic signal heads at various locations at intersections on CO 45 from Prairie Ave to Wildhorse Rd, Eagleridge Blvd & Elizabeth St, I-25 Ramps at Eagleridge, US 50A from McCulloch Blvd to N Elizabeth St, US 50B at Norwood Ave & Troy Ave, CO 96A from Santa Fe Ave to Portland Ave.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PUEBLO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS that:

SECTION 1:

The Pueblo Area Council of Governments (PACOG) expresses its desire to use HAZ and HOT funds with state matching funds for a total of \$585,000 for backplate installation.

SECTION 2:

The PACOG certifies that the transportation planning process is being carried out in conformance with all applicable federal requirements; and hereby directs the Urban Transportation Planning Division to implement the necessary revisions to the Fiscal Year 2025–2028 Pueblo Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Improvement Program to include this amendment.

SECTION 3:

This Resolution shall become effective upon passage and approval.
