

RESOLUTION NO. 25-010

A RESOLUTION ASSIGNING UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION MULTIMODAL PROJECT DISCRETIONARY GRANT (MPDG), IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,500,000.00, ASSIGNING COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION STATE MATCHING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000,000, ASSIGNING FEDERAL REGIONAL PRIORITY PROGRAMMING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,025,799, AND ASSIGNING STATE REGIONAL PRIORITY PROGRAMMING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,084,117 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF 12 PASSING LANES ALONG US50

WHEREAS, United States Department of Transportation Multimodal Project Discretionary Grant Funds were awarded to the Colorado Department of Transportation for \$40,500,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Transportation, in partnership with Otero County, is to provide approved State funds of \$15,000,000.00 to be used as match; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Transportation is to provide approved Federal Regional Priority Programming funds of \$10,025,799; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Transportation is to provide approved State Regional Priority Programming funds of \$2,084,117 for the construction of 12 passing lanes between Pueblo and the Kansas State Line along US50.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PUEBLO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS that:

SECTION 1:

The Pueblo Area Council of Governments expresses its desire to use Multimodal Project Discretionary Grant funds with additional funds for a total of \$67,609,916 to construct passing lanes along US50.

SECTION 2:


The PACOG certifies that the transportation planning process is being carried out in conformance with all applicable federal requirements; and hereby directs the Urban Transportation Planning Division to implement the necessary revisions to the Fiscal Year 2025–2028 Pueblo Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Improvement Program to include this amendment.
