

RESOLUTION NO. 24-015

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE PUEBLO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2023-2027 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) ASSIGNING FISCAL YEAR 2024 COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION REGION 2 HAZARD ELIMINATION POOL FOR THE DESIGN OF A FUTURE SIGNAL AND INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AT PUEBLO BOULEVARD AND MIRROR AVENUE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$232,120.

Whereas the Pueblo Area Council of Governments and the Colorado Department of Transportation have cooperatively developed the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-2027 Pueblo Area Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) in conjunction with the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP); and

Whereas all projects that appear in the FY 2023-2027 PACOG Transportation Improvement Program shall also be included in the Colorado State Transportation Improvement Program, if required; and

Whereas the PACOG planning staff has received a request from Colorado Department of Transportation Region 2 for the following project to be added to the FY 2023-2027 TIP.

Project Name: SH 45 (Pueblo Blvd) & Mirror Avenue Safety Improvements
Federal Funds: \$208,908
State Funds: \$ 23,212
Local Matching Funds: \$ 0
TOTAL PROJECT AMOUNT: \$232,120

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PUEBLO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS that:

SECTION 1:

The FY 2023-2027 PACOG TIP is hereby amended to program to the following project for FY 2024 Hazard Elimination pool to the design of a future signal and intersection improvements at Pueblo Boulevard and Mirror Avenue.

SECTION 2:

The PACOG certifies that the transportation planning process is being carried out in conformance with all applicable federal requirements; and hereby directs the Urban Transportation Planning Division to implement the necessary revisions to the Fiscal Year 2023–2027 Pueblo MPO TIP to include this amendment.

SECTION 3:

This Resolution shall become effective upon passage and approval.
