

RESOLUTION NO. 25-008

A RESOLUTION ASSIGNING FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION CHARGING AND FUELING INFRASTRUCTURE (CFI) GRANT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,520,192.00 AND ASSIGNING CITIZENS ENERGY MATCHING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,880,048.00 FOR THE INSTALLATION OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING EQUIPMENT IN LOW-INCOME NEIGHBORHOODS AND AT MULTI-FAMILY HOUSING UNITS.

WHEREAS, Federal Highway Administration Charging and Fueling Infrastructure Grant Funds awarded \$11,520,192.00 to the City of Pueblo; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pueblo has partnered with the non-profit, Citizens Energy, to provide approved funds of \$2,880,048.00 to be used as match for the Installation of Electric Vehicle Charging Equipment in low-income neighborhoods and at multi-family housing units.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PUEBLO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS that:

SECTION 1:

The Pueblo Area Council of Governments expresses its desire to use Charging and Fueling Infrastructure Grant funds and Citizens Energy match funds for a total of \$14,400,240.00 to install Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructure.

SECTION 2:

The PACOG certifies that the transportation planning process is being carried out in conformance with all applicable federal requirements; and hereby directs the Urban Transportation Planning Division to implement the necessary revisions to the Fiscal Year 2025–2028 Pueblo Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Improvement Program to include this amendment.

SECTION 3:

This Resolution shall become effective upon passage and approval.
