

RESOLUTION NO. 25-002

A RESOLUTION ASSIGNING FISCAL YEAR 2024 FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION SAFE STREETS FOR ALL PLANNING AND DEMONSTRATION GRANT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$959,559 AND ASSIGNING \$239,890 MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE CITY OF PUEBLO, FOR THE PUEBLO SUPPLEMENTAL PLANNING AND DEMONSTRATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Pueblo Area Council Governments Metropolitan Planning Organization included Fiscal Year 2022 Safe Streets and Roads for All Planning Grant for the City of Pueblo Safety Action Plan in the amount of \$681,600 from the Federal Highway and Administration and match funds from City of Pueblo in the amount of \$174,400 into Transportation Improvement Program FY 2023-2027 on May 16, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Federal Highway Administration Fiscal Year 2024 Safe Streets for All (SS4A) awarded \$959,559 to the City of Pueblo, a member of the Pueblo Area Council of Governments (PACOG) planning area, for the Pueblo Supplemental Planning and Demonstration Project; and

WHEREAS, The City of Pueblo has authorized the amount of \$239,890 as match for the Pueblo Supplemental Planning and Demonstration Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PUEBLO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS that:

SECTION 1:

The Pueblo Area Council of Governments expresses its desire to use Safe Streets for All Grant funds and City of Pueblo Matching funds, for a total of \$1,199,449, for the Pueblo Supplemental Planning and Demonstration Project which will revise the City of Pueblo *Roadway Classification Design Standards and Policies* document and perform demonstration activities based on the data from the (in-progress) Safety Action Plan.

SECTION 2:


The PACOG certifies that the transportation planning process is being carried out in conformance with all applicable federal requirements; and hereby directs the Urban Transportation Planning Division to implement the necessary revisions to the Fiscal Year 2025–2028 Pueblo Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Improvement Program to include this amendment.
