

RESOLUTION NO. 25-023

A RESOLUTION ASSIGNING COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (CDOT) VULNERABLE ROAD USER (VRU) PROGRAM FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$788,150 TO INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AT US HIGHWAY 50B & HUDSON AVE./BONFORTE BLVD.

WHEREAS, Colorado Department of Transportation assigned state Vulnerable Road User (VRU) Program Funds in the amount of \$788,150 for intersection improvements to address VRU safety at the intersection of US Highway 50B & Hudson Ave./Bonforte Blvd.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PUEBLO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS that:

SECTION 1:

The Pueblo Area Council of Governments (PACOG) expresses its desire to use VRU program funds for a total of \$788,150 for intersection improvements.

SECTION 2:

The PACOG certifies that the transportation planning process is being carried out in conformance with all applicable federal requirements; and hereby directs the Urban Transportation Planning Division to implement the necessary revisions to the Fiscal Year 2025–2028 Pueblo Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include this amendment.

SECTION 3:

This Resolution shall become effective upon passage and approval.
