

RESOLUTION NO. 25-021

A RESOLUTION ASSIGNING COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FEDERAL HAZARD ELIMINATION PROGRAM (HAZ) FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,690,000 AND ASSIGNING STATE MATCHING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$410,000 FOR A TOTAL OF \$4,100,000 TO SIGNAL INSTALLATION AND INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, Colorado Department of Transportation assigned federal Hazard Elimination Program (HAZ) Funds in the amount of \$3,690,000; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Department of Transportation assigned state match funds in the amount of \$410,000 for signal installation and intersection improvements at CO 47A & Pete Jimenez Parkway and US 50C & 27th Lane.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PUEBLO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS that:

SECTION 1:

The Pueblo Area Council of Governments (PACOG) expresses its desire to use HAZ funds with state matching funds for a total of \$4,100,000 for signal installation and intersection improvements.

SECTION 2:

The PACOG certifies that the transportation planning process is being carried out in conformance with all applicable federal requirements; and hereby directs the Urban Transportation Planning Division to implement the necessary revisions to the Fiscal Year 2025–2028 Pueblo Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Improvement Program to include this amendment.

SECTION 3:

This Resolution shall become effective upon passage and approval.
