

RESOLUTION NO. 2024.023

A RESOLUTION ASSIGNING THE STATE OF COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, COLORADO PARKS AND WILDLIFE, LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUNDS, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$875,000 AND ASSIGNING AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 603(C) (1) PROJECT NO CI2113 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$875,000 FOR PLAY FAIR PARK (LAKE MINNEQUA) TO BE AN ACCESSIBLE AND INCLUSIVE PLAYGROUND AND TRAIL.

WHEREAS, Colorado Parks and Wildlife Land and Water Conservation Funds awarded \$875,000.00 to the City of Pueblo , a member of the Pueblo Area Council of Governments (PACOG) planning area to the Play Fair Park; and

WHEREAS, Project No. C12113 American Rescue Plan Act funds of \$875,000 has been authorized as match for the Play Fair Park. This project includes constructing a concrete trail, wheelchair accessible fishing docks, play areas, shelter, bathrooms, sports fields, and courts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PUEBLO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS that:

SECTION 1:

The Pueblo Area Council of Governments expresses its desire to use Land and Water Conservation and American Rescue Plan Act funds for a total of \$1,750,000 to construct an accessible trail and amenities for all users at Lake Minnequa.

SECTION 2:


The PACOG certifies that the transportation planning process is being carried out in conformance with all applicable federal requirements; and hereby directs the Urban Transportation Planning Division to implement the necessary revisions to the Fiscal Year 2025–2028 Pueblo Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Improvement Program to include this amendment.

SECTION 3:

This Resolution shall become effective upon passage and approval.
