

RESOLUTION NO. 24-028

A RESOLUTION ASSIGNING FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION REBUILDING AMERICAN INFRASTRUCTURE WITH SUSTAINABILITY AND EQUITY GRANT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,836,514.48 FOR THE PLANNING AND CONSTRUCTION OF MULTIMODAL TRAILS, EXPANSION OF MOBILITY HUB AND WATER WORKS PARK MULTIMODAL ACCESS.

WHEREAS, Federal Highway Administration Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) awarded \$8,836,514.48 to Pueblo County, a member of the Pueblo Area Council of Governments (PACOG) planning area, for the Connecting Communities Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PUEBLO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS that:

SECTION 1:

The Pueblo Area Council of Governments expresses its desire to use Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity Grant funds for a total of \$8,836,514.48 for the Connecting Communities Project which will plan and construct multimodal trails, expansion of a mobility HUB, and plan and design a corridor to Water Works Park.


SECTION 2:
